2. Colour in the box using any colours you like. (Just don't cover the writing, or people won't know what the box is for!)
3. **Carefully** cut out around the outside of the large shape (Ask a grown-up for help)





We make food parcels for children as well as parcels for grown-ups



A food parcel has enough food to last for three days

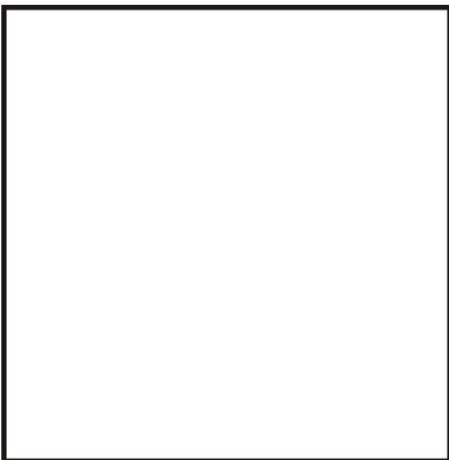

TAB "A"

4. Cut out the money slot (below)
5. Fold along the remaining lines, and glue TAB "A" behind PANEL "D"
6. Fold the bottom flaps together in number order, and tuck the end of flap 4 into the slot formed.
7. Cut out the separate square (below) and glue it inside the bottom of your box, for added strength
8. Glue TAB "B" behind PANEL "D", glue TAB "C" behind PANEL "B", and glue TAB "D" behind PANEL "C"



9. Leave box somewhere safe where it will be seen by lots of people.
 10. When you have finished collecting money, give it to your teacher or parent and ask them to send it to Luton Foodbank. (See lutonfoodbank.org.uk/contact for details.)
